The Hungarian Rectors' Conference (HRC) is an independent public corporation registered by the court, representing the entire higher education system in Hungary. Governed by its Statutes, the HRC is structured with a four-level system: the Plenary Session, comprising 63 rectors, various specialized committees, a Presidency of 12+3 members, and a supporting Secretariat. As a non-profit entity, HRC's core duty is to provide efficient single-channel domestic and foreign professional representation for Hungarian higher education institutions.

The HRC also represents Hungarian higher education on an international level, with the right to delegate representatives to key organizations like the International Association of Universities (IAU) and the European University Association (EUA). HRC is committed to promoting Hungarian higher education and fostering global partnerships. It plays a key role in organizing events, managing delegations, and coordinating programs for international students.

HRC regularly organizes bilateral conferences and delegation visits to nurture cooperation. In recent years we stablishes strong relations with many partners, such as with Morocco, Egypt, Argentina, Cuba, Colombia, Vietnam, China, Uzbekistan and Kyrgyzstan. The HRC is also committed to building regional and European partnerships, with active participation in European and international organizations such as EUA, EURASHE, EFEE, and IAU.





The Grand Hall of the Academy's Art Nouveau main building dating from 1907 boasts unparalleled acoustics, and as the complete reconstruction was finished in 2013, the university has set up a professional concert organizing department and founded two world-renowned international competitions: the Éva Marton International Singing Competition and the Bartók World Competition.

The Debrecen Reformed Theological University (DRTU) as a member institute of the Debrecen Reformed College (founded in 1538) has been one of the influential centres of theological sciences and ecclesiastic training of intellectuals in Hungary.

Debrecen turned the ecclesiastic centre of the Tiszántúl (the region east of the river Tisza) which became protestant by the middle of the 16th century. At the time minister and teacher training in the region was carried out by the school of the city of Debrecen.

Thanks to its professors with experience from Western European universities, and an extended school network in the country and the protection, the rich support from the city of Debrecen and from the princes of Transylvania the Reformed College of Debrecen soon became an institution of national importance. Known as the school of the poor, it provided education for the lower layers of the society and supported their social advance. Besides notable scientists and science organizers, several poets, writers and philosophers well known in Hungarian cultural history are among the alumni of the College.

The DRTU currently has two institutes and seventeen departments. Our university apart from its undivided, basic (BA), master (MA) and PhD programmes carries out the training of would-be Reformed ministers and church employees, teachers and other secular intellectuals. The institute currently has 50 full time teachers and around 600 students.





We operate at the college-level BA in Theology and at the university-level MA in Theology in a form supported by the Hungarian Accreditation Committee and recognized by the state.





The Jewish Theological Seminary – University of Jewish Studies, Hungary (JTS–UJSH, or OR–ZSE) is a dynamically prospering small university under the auspices of the Federation of Hungarian Jewish Communities (Mazsihisz). Opened in 1877 as the rabbinical seminary (Landesrabbinerschule, or Jewish Theological Seminary) of the neolog (positive-historical) movement in Hungary, it is among the oldest institutions in the world training non-orthodox rabbis and cantors. It has gradually broadened its profile since the 1990s, and it was awarded a university status in 2000.

PENTECOSTAL THEOLOGICAL COLLEGE



The Pentecostal Theological College (PTC) was established in 1991 by the Evangelical Pentecostal Community to educate and train young people in a Pentecostal environment. Originally based in Kadarkút, it moved to Budapest in 1992, and in 1997, it relocated to a renovated building housing all its facilities.

In the new millennium, PTC emphasized practical service and academic excellence, integrating mission work into its curriculum. In 2003, it introduced a flexible credit-based system, and in 2006, adapted to EU higher education strategies, making the program more practice-oriented with a three-year academic course followed by a full-time service component.

PTC expanded its offerings with an Online Bible School in 2009 and launched an MA in Theology in 2012, supported by an expanded faculty and a new research institute. The institution's accreditation was renewed in 2014, and it continued to innovate with specialized courses like "Coaching and Leadership with a Christian Approach."

In 2019, PTC adopted a hybrid education model, blending online and classroom learning, ensuring modern, flexible theological education. This approach, combined with its rigorous academic standards, positions PTC as a leader in Pentecostal theological education.



REFORMED THEOLOGICAL UNIVERSITY OF SÁROSPATAK





The Reformed Theological University of Sárospatak is a higher education institution of the Reformed Church of Hungary. It is an independent legal body maintained by the Tiszáninnen Reformed Church District.

As an academic institution of the Reformed College of Sárospatak (founded in 1531), it has trained ministers for centuries. Despite the protest of the Tiszáninnen Synod, its functioning was ceased by administrative decree in 1951. After a forty-year forced intermission, the Church District restarted the Theological Academy in 1991. This was acknowledged by the Government Decree 1991:1059 of the Hungarian Republic.

According to the amendment of the Higher Education Act (12 December 2023), our institution, as a non-state university of applied sciences, continues its work as the Sárospatak Reformed Theological University from 1 February 2024.

The University preserves and carries on an intellectual and spiritual legacy that was developed in specific circumstances and which is built on centuries-old creeds and on a commitment to the Hungarian nation.

The purpose of the University is to train Reformed ministers and, according to the needs of the Reformed Church of Hungary, to train teachers of religious education, community organizers, social workers, and to conduct research in theology on a high standard. Given its historic legacy, it bears a responsibility not only to the Tiszáninnen Church District but also to the Hungarian Reformed Churches of the Carpathian Basin.





The academic purpose of the full-time and part-time Theology BA course, as well as the postgraduate specialized training course is: theological education – irrespective of denominational affiliation and without denominational nature – for all who wish to acquire higher education in theology based on the principle of 'sola Scriptura'.

In the Bible's research, the college considers it important to have scientific precision and sophistication, and to use linguistic and historical auxiliary sciences for this purpose.

However, the ultimate goal and essence is considered to be the exploration and teaching of the thought contents of the Scriptures on the basis of correct explanatory principles.





In addition to / after theology, the following disciplines are pursued in the liberal arts (in order of magnitude): philosophy and religion, history, linguistics and literature, psychology, furthermore research of state and legal studies in the field of social sciences. More than a hundred research topics are underway in the three fields of science. Of utmost importance (as a research related to the training) is the incorporation of Bible translation and its findings into teaching and curricula, and the re-channeling of educational results into further research.

THEOLOGICAL COLLEGE OF EGER



A higher education institution maintained by a church. The organisation of the college in Eger was started by Bishop István Telekessy in 1700. Education began in 1704, but the institute's charter was not issued until 1709 by Bishop Telekessy. The building took its present form in the second half of the 18th century. The Baroque chapel was painted in 1825. Until 1951, only students from the diocese of Eger studied here, but now priests from the dioceses of Debrecen-Nyíregyháza and Vác are also trained here.

The Institute currently offers three types of training. The full-time course is an undivided theology and clergy course (6 years). In accordance with the Bologna Process, the training of theology teachers is divided into two cycles. After completing the basic course in catechetics-pastoral associate (BA, 6 semesters), the training of pastoral care teachers (MA, 5 semesters) is carried out in cooperation with Eszterházy Károly College.

The college includes the St. John's Centre for Continuing Education, which is located in the new wing of the college. It is an adult education institution of the Diocese of Eger. It organises spiritual exercises and courses for the faithful of the world to deepen their faith.

THEOLOGICAL COLLEGE OF ESZTERGOM





The founding of the Theological College of Esztergom can be traced back to the post-Tridentine era, following the Council of Trent (1545-1563), which mandated the improvement of priestly education through the establishment of seminaries. In 1566, Archbishop Miklós Oláh of Esztergom founded a seminary in Nagyszombat (present-day Trnava), where priestly training began in 1567. Over the centuries, the seminary underwent various transformations and relocations, including its eventual move to Esztergom in 1865. The college's modern iteration, as recognized in Hungarian higher education law. became an autonomous ecclesiastical institution in 2012, focusing solely on theological education for seminarians. The college is part of the Archdiocese of Esztergom-Budapest and operates within the historical building known as the "Nagyszeminárium," now part of the Saint Adalbert Center.

UNIVERSITY OF VETERINARY **MEDICINE BUDAPEST**





In 1787, a "Chair for Animal Healing" was established at the Faculty of Medicine in Pest to provide medical students with basic knowledge of animal diseases. As horse and cattle breeding expanded on the Hungarian plains in the early 19th century, the Chair became independent from the Medical Faculty in 1851, forming the Royal Institute of Veterinary Medicine. By 1899, it had achieved Royal College status, allowing it to issue D.V.M. diplomas, and earned an international reputation in the first half of the 20th century.

In 1960, the school gained the status of an independent university, further cementing its role as a leading institution in veterinary education. However, in 2000, as part of a nationwide reorganization of higher education, it became the Faculty of Veterinary Science within the newly established Szent István University.

In 2016, the institution regained its independence, once again becoming the University of Veterinary Medicine, Budapest. It continues to operate as a state university, with its programs continually accredited by the Hungarian Accreditation Board.
